




UK DEVELOPMENT

UKRAINE WAR

The war in Ukraine continues to distrubt and destroy lives in Ukraine. Our teams find it hard to work efficiently, when safety on the streets is not guaranteed, when power cuts can take most of the day, when lifts in apartment blocks cannot be trusted (due to power cuts!) and distances to open airports have hugely increased travel times. In some cases, the safest route out of Ukraine is through Moldova. In all these difficulties, our teams continue to rescue, return and restore the Jewish population of Ukraine, saving some from the frontlines, by risking their own lives.

France has the largest Jewish population in Europe and the third largest in the world. The Jewish population is over 450,000 with the majority being in Paris.


Marseille is the 2nd city and the city where Ezra France is based.

In 2015 almost 8,000 French Jews made Aliyah after several terrorist attacks against the Jews in France #JeSuisCharlie. In the years prior to that there were around 2,000 Jews per year leaving France for Israel.



After October 7th Massacre and resulting rise in anti-semitism, the numbers of applications for Aliyah had grown by 158% in January 2024, according to Jewish Agency! The numbers are expected to climb even higher next year. Ezra in France is seeing an increase in people contacting Ezra for help. "It's like a snowball that keeps on growing," says Maria, our representative in France. "Every day there are Aliyah flights from major cities in France, but despite this, many Olim are forced to fly from Germany and Switzerland because there are not enough tickets from France!"

This July, 45 people helped by Ezra made Aliyah in contrast to 16 in July of last year. There currently are further 90 people in the pipeline for Aliyah process through Ezra. While we thank God for the new urgency of French Jews to find their home in Israel, we are saddened by the increased anti-semitism and unrest in France.
