The majority of the Moldovan Jews live in the capital, Kishinev. Many of them are elderly and almost 80% of them report significant economic hardship. Ezra's been helping them to reach Israel since 2004.

When the Ukrainian war restarted in 2022, in the first weeks Ezra helped around 2000 Ukrainian Jews make their Aliyah through Kishinev! Now-a-days around 60 Jews leave Kishinev each month with Ezra's help.

#### 350'000 Moldovan Jews dead!

The Moldovan Jewish population has known tremendous tragedy through the centuries. One of the early pogroms in the early 1900s took place in Kishinev in 1903. Hundreds of innocent people were killed and thousands left homeless. A memorial was later erected to commemorate this tragic event, pictured on earlier page. The Moldovan Jewish community suffered greatly also during the Second World War. Over 350,000 Jews perished in ghettos, concentration camps and during the deportations!

Tragedy hit again during Moldovan civil war in 1992 when thousands of Moldovan Jews were deported to Odessa, Ukraine, for safety. The country split into two regions, the Moldovan Republic and Transnistria. Today the split continues even though Transnistria is not recognised as a nation which gives additional problems for the Jewish community living there.

## 'Let there be light!'



Each night of the 8 days of Hanukkah, Jewish families light a candle, using the 9th candle in the middle of Hanukkah Menorah, remembering how God's temple in Jerusalem once more was dedicated and bore the continual light ordained in the Law of Moses. It was this temple, thus dedicated, that Jesus himself worshipped in and was brought into as a baby of 8 days old. At the first day of Creation, God said: 'Let there be light!' and this was before the sun was revealed. It tells us the true light that sustains life is not of the sun but of God Himself!
