






ALIYAH SUMMER COURSE

I was afraid that I would wake up and all this would vanish into thin air! The reports vary regarding the actual number of Jews in Azerbaijan which consists of three different subgroups, the mountain Jews, Ashkenazi Jews and Georgian Jews.

Some estimates say there are over 16'000 Jews still living in Azerbaijan, in lively communities in various cities and clusters, in relative harmony with their muslim neighbours, some wealthy, some desperately poor.
